Little, from Rum Cay, worked with two local artisans to recycle conch shells into jewelry forms shaped as marlins, sailfish, turtles and other sea life native to the Bahamas.

Through tournament guest donations some \$1,200 was raised and a portion was targeted for the purchase of special saws and equipment that the local artisans can apply towards creating unique, locally crafted conch jewelry for their shops.

Old Bahama Bay, a member of the Guy Harvey Outpost Resorts Expedition Properties portfolio, hosted its inaugural Bonfire Series in February 2015, with the ceremonial burning of Bobby Little's wahoo sculpture as a tournament highlight.
