

DERBY RULES & WAIVER

EVENT

Friday, June 28, 2024

Mandatory Captain's Pre-briefing 6:30 PM at Cove Waterfront Restaurant, 1754 SE 3rd Ct, Deerfield Beach, FL 33441. One member of the team must be present at the Captain's Pre-briefing. Those who don't check-in will not be eligible for participation as all teams <u>must</u> have a signed waiver from each team members by the end of the Captain's Meeting.

Saturday, June 29, 2024

Harvesting begins at first light and ends at 6:00 pm.

Weigh Station opens at 1:00 pm and closes at 6:00 pm at Cove Waterfront Restaurant, 1754 SE 3rd Ct, Deerfield Beach, FL 33441 with awards immediately following weigh in.

Awards ceremony -6:00-7:00 PM

TEAM REGISTRATION

- 1. Registration will be available at www.OperationLionfish.com. Payment is due at time of registration. Teams must read and understand the Rules prior to registering. By registering teams understand they will abide by the rules and those of the tournament director.
- 2. Non-refundable registration fees are \$100 per team.
- 3. Teams must be registered by 7:00 pm on Friday, June 28, 2024.
- 4. Teams will be limited to 2 divers. More than one team may be present on the same boat or teams can also split up between multiple boats. Each member must declare a team name upon registration. Once registration is closed, teams are locked. Teams may not substitute participants during the tournament for any reason and will be subject to disqualification.
- 5. Team names must not be offensive in nature. "Offensive" will be determined by the Tournament Director and may require teams to modify their names at any time.

6. Registration includes entry into Operation Lionfish and Events including Captain Bouncer's Fishing Seminar, Friday night from 6:00 -7:30 pm at the Cove.

ACCEPTABLE FISH

- 1. Lionfish (*Pterois volitans/miles*) eligible for entry may only be taken during the tournament hours. No previously caught or frozen lionfish will be allowed. Please keep all lionfish on ice.
- 2. Only legal means of capture in areas allowing use of those gear types will be allowed. All existing federal, state, and local laws must be followed.
- 3. All lionfish must be in whole condition (no missing heads or tails). Largest and smallest fish will be determined by total length of the fish in millimeters measuring from tip of snout to tip of tail. If the tail is damaged, scientifically-recognized standard length may be used as determined by the weighmaster.
- 4. Lionfish caught during the tournament may be donated for sampling, research or for consumption during the event days. Fish must be preserved on ice. All other lionfish not donated or sold must be disposed of properly by the individual capturing the lionfish.
- 5. Protective gloves should be worn when handling lionfish. Participants are encouraged to carry appropriate first aid kit specific for Lionfish stings.

TOURNAMENT HOURS

- 1. Teams may start from any waters where lionfish are legal to harvest. Tournament Hours are first light until 6:00 PM on Saturday June 29, 2024.
- 2. All waters are eligible for tournament harvest. The tournament shall take place regardless of weather conditions. Captains make their own decisions about whether to venture out.

SCORING STATION HOURS

Lionfish may only be taken during tournament hours and the fish must be presented to the scoring station. Scoring station will be located at the Cove Waterfront Restaurant. The Scoring Station will open on Saturday, June 29, 2024 from 1:00-6:00 pm. All fish must be present at the scoring station by 6:00 PM to be counted.

SCORING STATION PROCEDURES

- 1. Teams must have lionfish in coolers and properly iced.
- 2. Team captain or designee must deliver the coolers to the designated scoring location and check in with the scoring station staff, who will verify the number of coolers and place tape across the lid of the cooler indicating the team name and number of coolers associated with the team. Teams need to declare at this time whether lionfish will be sold, donated or kept.

3. It is highly recommended that the team captain or team member be present when the fish are being counted and measured by scoring station staff. If there is a backup at the scoring station, team captain / member does not have to stand next to their coolers, but stay close enough where scoring station staff can locate them quickly.

TOURNAMENT AWARDS

- 1. Prizes will be awarded for most lionfish, largest lionfish, and smallest lionfish based on the number of teams.
- 2. Only one winning entry per team will be allowed in EACH category. In the event of a tie the winning team or individual will be determined by the earliest check in of their lionfish at the scoring station.
- 3. Cash awards will be presented to the team based on the number of team entries.

- 1. The Lionfish tournament is an honor system tournament with all registrants being responsible for compliance with the rules.
- 2. Any violation of these rules resulting in disqualification will result in forfeiture of entry fee, prizes and cash awards, and at the sole discretion of the tournament officials, prohibited from entry in any future tournaments.
- 3. All decisions of the tournament director and rules committee are final.

PROMOTIONAL PURPOSES

All entrants agree to allow tournament officials and Guy Harvey Resorts to use participant's name, awards, and photos for any media and promotional purposes.

2. Diving: In the context of this document, Diving shall mean free diving, snorkel diving, SCUBA diving, spear fishing, netting (or otherwise using any methods allowed under the rules) to harvest Lionfish while in or on the water.
3. In the context of this document, the word "I" shall mean me, my heirs, survivors, assigns, representatives, estate, legal guardian, attorneys in fact, or anyone else who may be empowered to act on my behalf. Or, if I am signing as the legal guardian of a registrant, then it shall mean my ward, me, my ward's heirs, survivors, assigns, representatives, estate, attorneys in fact, legal guardian, and anyone else who may act on behalf of my ward, principal, or minor.
