Guy Harvey Outpost hotel debuts in St. Pete Beach

A hotel chain linked to Fort Lauderdale-based marine conservationist and artist Guy Harvey has opened its first U.S. resort: the 211-room [Guy Harvey Outpost](#), a [TradeWinds Beach Resort](#) on St. Pete Beach in west Florida.

The property was formerly known as TradeWinds Sandpiper Hotel and Suites.

Renovations are still being completed, but plans call for all guest rooms to be updated and feature Guy Harvey art by January. There also will be a Guy Harvey gallery of fish from the Tampa area, complete with descriptions of those species.
